



Available Video Connections

Available Table/Podium Video Connections.

One HDMI and typically one analog VGA with audio connection will be available at the judge's bench, prosecution, defense, GAL locations, with some courtrooms having a connection at the podium. Adapters and or interface cables other than the supplied HDMI and VGA will **NOT** be available or provided by the courtrooms. It is always best practice to come in a day early or at least the morning before the courtroom is scheduled to begin to test your equipment with the provided technology. The courtrooms are not responsible for your equipment being connected to the systems or how your equipment works once it is connected. Be proactive and test your equipment before you begin.



Microsoft Surface Hub.

The courtrooms are equipped with a portable surface hub that is connected to the courtroom technology. The surface Hub will provide connectivity over teams to bring others into the Courtroom via video or audio calls. The ability to cast your presentations to the surface hub wirelessly is available for Microsoft PC users with that ability. Guest with Apple or Mac product may bring their own wireless presenting devices to the courtroom and can connect with the supplied HDMI connections. Equipment brought into the court room to connect to the courtroom technology is the responsibility of others. Testing before use is strongly recommended.
