
I. GENERAL POLICY

It is the policy of the Wyoming Judicial Branch that any new or newly retained judicial officer shall execute an oath of office.

II. FILING OATH OF OFFICE

- A. A Supreme Court justice shall file his or her oath of office with the Secretary of State. A district, chancery, and circuit court judge or magistrate shall file his or her oath of office with the office of the county clerk of the county in which the oath is taken.
- B. A filed copy of the oath of office shall be sent to the Human Resources Division of the Wyoming Judicial Branch's Administrative Office of the Courts.
