INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Wyoming Judicial Branch's Annual Statistical Report for Fiscal Year 2026. This report offers a clear, data-driven look at our state's judicial system, highlighting the caseload trends and year-over-year changes that shape how our courts serve Wyoming communities. It reflects our ongoing commitment to transparency and accountability, and to using solid data as the foundation for sound decisions.

METHODS

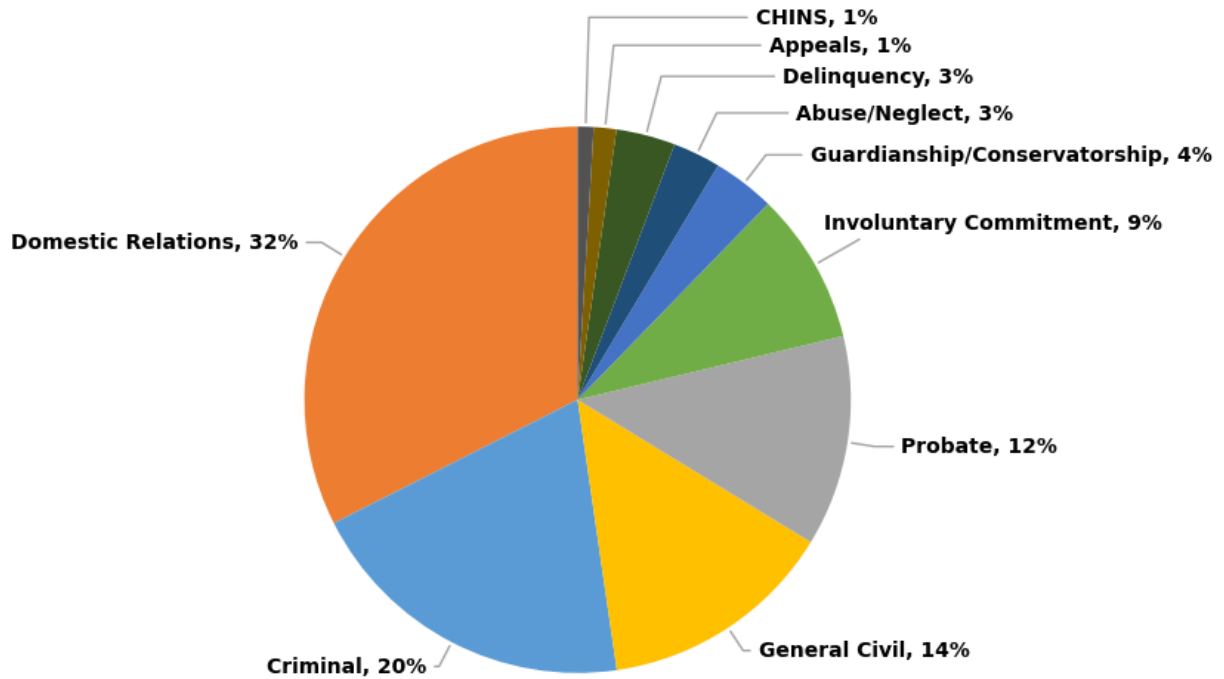
This report draws on case statistics from Wyoming's district courts during fiscal year 2026 (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026). Our analysis relies on the statistical model developed by the Court Statistics Project (CSP), which enables meaningful comparisons between Wyoming's case data and benchmarks from other states nationwide.

Because the CSP model tracks more than 80 distinct case types, we condense that detail into 10 broader categories for district courts, making year-to-year trends easier to follow at a glance.

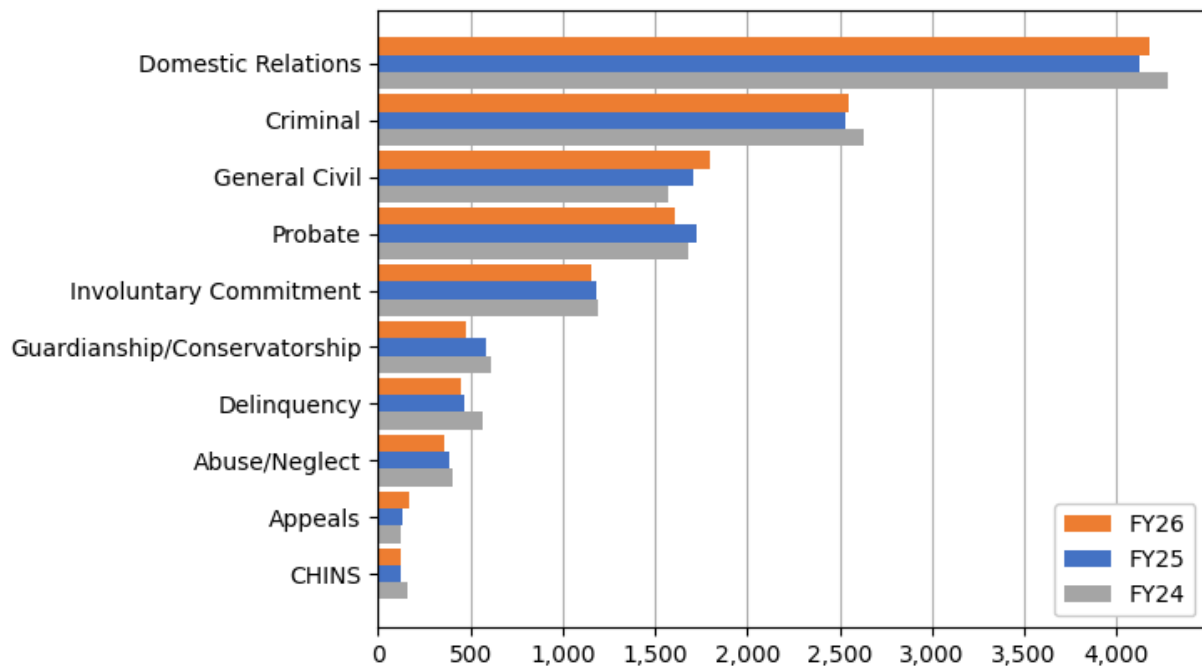
Together, these data collection and reporting practices are designed to give a clearer, more useful picture of district court activity across Wyoming.

District Court Proportion of Cases by Category FY26

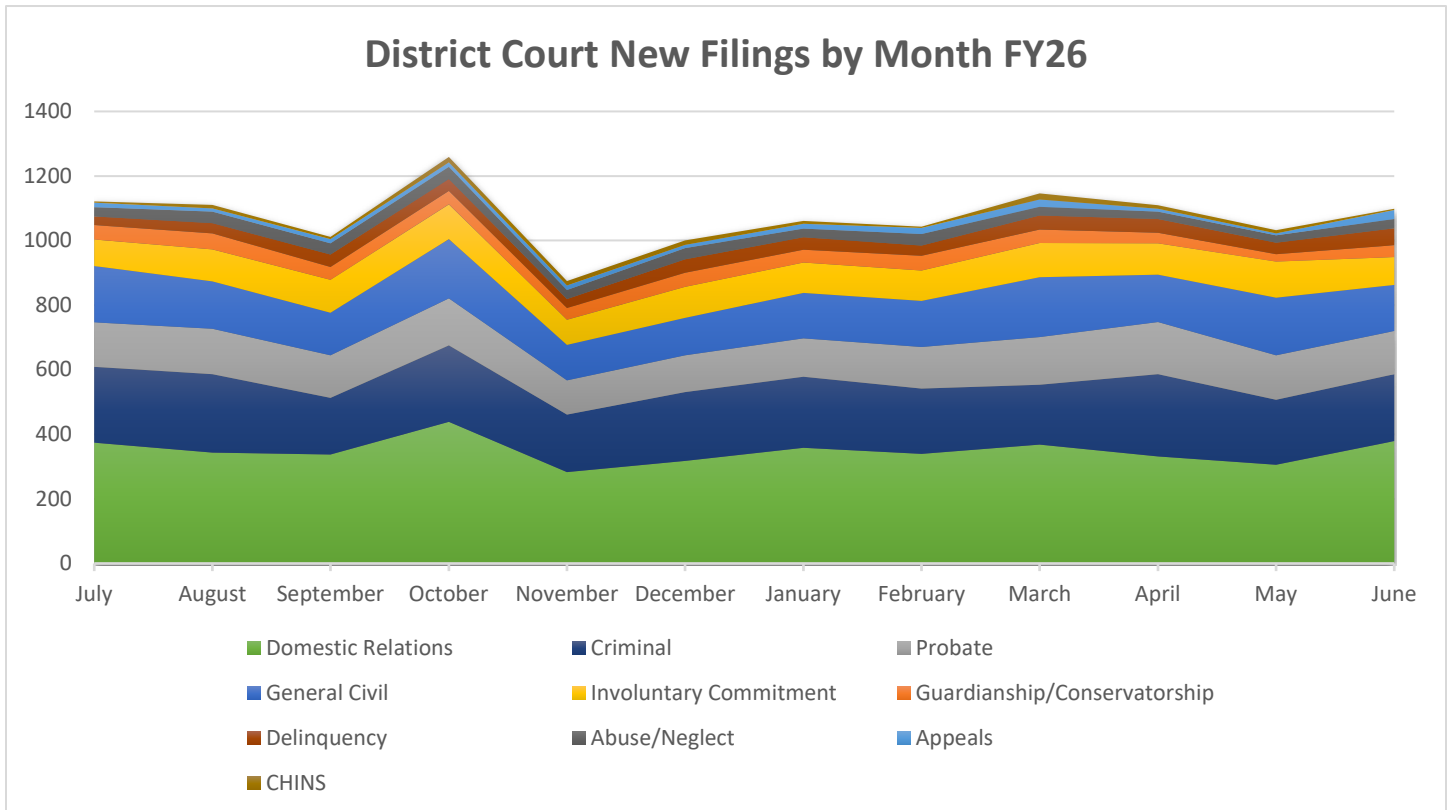


District Court New Filings By Case Category, FY24-FY26
